I BELIEVE!

For so many years, I was satisfied with a belief in a “symbolic” Resurrection! The belief that when you reach the bottom of the pit, you will go up again. The belief that every winter is followed by a spring. But I would not dare believe in an eternal Spring.

Many people still believe this way. They think religion is only there to give us more zest in life, to invite us to reach the maximum of our potential, to invite us to love again after our love has been rejected, to trust again after our trust has been betrayed. Yes, this is all true. But it is all absurd if there is no life after death. How God could demand total surrender from us and then let us die forever saying “Too bad, my friend, I can no longer do anything for you”, or even worse “I don't care for you, now that you are just a dead piece of meat”.

No, if the God of Jesus is real, He cares for us over and beyond death. As I write this paragraph, I remember my friend Robert Brekermans who died one year ago. How could God allow such a beautiful life to end so abruptly? Robert and I were the same age. He was about to retire in order to serve the Church full time for the rest of his life. He had come to a point where he could give back all that he had received and find meaning in bearing fruit that last.

But with all my heart, I believe that he is alive and bearing much fruit, even for this St. Mary's Parish. I believe he is alive, his very person, that he can remember his past on earth and foresee his eternity with us, when our mortal bodies of flesh will be transformed in the image and likeness of the Resurrected Christ. I believe this because Christ said it and did it! I believe this because his apostles testified about it at the price of their own blood.

May you have a Joyful Easter, Fr Pierre

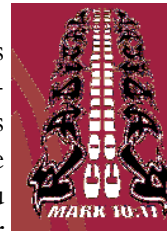
