THE MESSIAH ANNOINTED BY A WOMAN?

Recently I learned that a parent forbade his daughter to become an altar-server. He sincerely believed that a certain church rule forbade any women to come close to the altar. There is no such rule in today's church. In Jesus' life, some women had extraordinary roles. Mary Magdalene was the first one to see the Resurrected Christ and witness about it. The Samaritan woman become the first evangelizer of her village. Mary of Bethany, a close friend of Jesus, obtained from Him the resurrection of her brother Lazarus. Today's account of the Passion "opens with the story of the loving waste of expensive perfume in Bethany" on Jesus' head which according to John, was done by Mary of Bethany. Of course some men were angry and said to one another, "Why was this ointment wasted in this way? For this ointment could have been sold for more than three hundred denarii (a year's worth of wages) and the money given to the poor." One of the greatest theologians of the 20th century, Cardinal Hans Urs von Balthasar wrote:

Jesus brushes off all the criticism: the woman has done the right thing — she has anointed him (Messiah means "anointed one") for his death. This is the final act of the loving Church, which retains its validity to the end of the world. Wastefulness is the original Christian attitude, only thereafter does calculating charity for the poor have its place. After his death has become a certainty because of Judas' betrayal, Jesus wastes himself even more boundlessly in his Eucharist. Everyone drinks the shed blood in advance, and this will continue to take place to the end of the world. The entire Passion occurs under the sign of this complete self-wasting of God's love for the world. (From Light of the Word, Ignatius Press, page 182)

Another great theologian, Cardinal Ratzinger who became Pope Benedict XVI, said, "Only when someone values love more highly than life, that is, only when someone is ready to put life second to love, for the sake of love, can love be stronger and more than death. If it is to be more than death it must first be more than life."
