**Pastor's
Corner**

How do you know you are in the Father's hand?

Dear Parishioners, I learned about shepherding from my friends who had been shepherds in the back-country of Portugal some fifty years ago. Their ways of tending the sheep were almost unchanged since Christ's time. Each shepherd would bring his flock to a good pasture. During the dry season, the different flocks would have to share the same "secret" pastures. As a result, the sheep from different flocks would mingle together and form a huge flock. How could the shepherds discern their own sheep from the others and separate their flocks? After all, all the sheep look alike. The sheep themselves don't recognize their own fellow sheep! The only way they could regroup in their original flock would be through the voice of their own shepherd. So each shepherd would stand at a different corner of the pasture and from there, each one would simultaneously call his own sheep with a special call. Immediately, each sheep would recognize the voice of his shepherd, among all others, and walk toward him. Soon all the flocks would be untangled and reconstituted.



We are Christ's sheep. Could we recognize his voice among others. Jesus said, "My sheep hear my voice. I know them and they follow me.... No one will snatch them out of hand" (John 10:27-28). Do I have such a sense of relatedness to the Lord? Such a personal bonding with him, as to enable me to discern his presence and his calling, anytime, anywhere? Mary Magdalene recognized Christ's voice in the cemetery by the way he spoke her name. If you pray to God, face to face, in good times and in bad, and seek to know his will and accomplish it daily, you will slowly learn to recognize his voice, not by its sound, but by its content, its relevance and timing. Then you will know that you are in the Father's hand. You will know that nothing and no one could snatch you out of it, without your consent.
