Dear Parishioners,

I was a teenager when my grandma died. I remember saying to myself, "I will never see again those eyes looking at me with tenderness. I will never again feel the caress of those old hands on my cheeks. I will never hear her heart beating as I lay my head against her chest. How will I know that she is still alive, that she is knowing me and loving me?" Her love could not be separated from her body. Seeing her body going down in the grave, I felt betrayed by God.

I believe something like that flashed through the Father's heart on Holy Saturday. Speaking to his dead Son, lying in the tomb, he said, " My Son, My Beloved Only Son, your body has spoken so well about your love for me and for all my children. Your body has spoken so well about my love for them. I cannot let go this body to the corruption of the grave. Your wounds, your human heart are forever inseparable from your Divine Person. I want you back home with your human heart and body. Forever, your body, healed and glorified by the Spirit, will be part of the joyful dance of the Holy Trinity. The whole world will be able to join us forever through your Sacred Resurrected Body. Your wounds will be a Source of Healing and Life Eternal. Your human heart will continue to beat for them. They will become part of you, my Only Son, by being baptized into your Body, by being nourished and loved by your Body. They will read in your "body - language" my love for them, and my love for you. They will experience the caress of Your hands through the hands of your disciples.

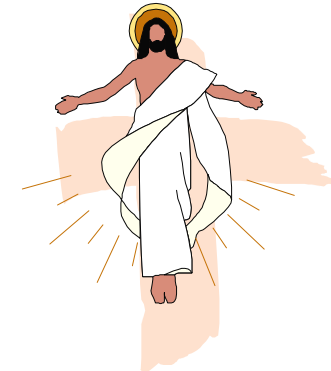

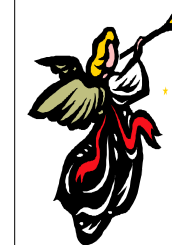

APRIL 15 - DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The Extraordinary Grace Promised by Jesus. I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession, and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy (Diary 1109). Whoever approaches the Fount of Life (Holy Communion) on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (Diary, 300). One should prepare by going to Confession within a week or two of the Feast day. One should receive Holy Communion on that day, venerate the Image and perform a spiritual or corporal work of mercy. Vatican grants indulgence to Divine Mercy Sunday. Three conditions for the Plenary indulgence granted as: (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who on Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, by the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or revered in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the Merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in You).
