"Conversion is, Above all, Acceptance"

Dear Parishioners,

The theme of today's homily in the light of this Sunday's readings, is on *conversion*. The following is the late Pope John Paul II's meditation on *conversion*:

"Conversion is not a one-way process... Being converted means believing in God who loved us first, who has loved us eternally in His Son, and through His Son gives us grace and truth in the Holy Spirit. That Son was crucified, so as to speak to us with His arms spread as widely as God is open to us. How incessantly God 'converts to us,' through the Cross of His Son!

Our conversion is in this way not a unilateral aspiration [a one way desire on our part] at all. It is not only an effort on the part of the human will, understanding and heart. It is not only a commitment to directing our humanity upwards, when it so heavily tends downwards.

Conversion is above all acceptance. It is the effort to accept God in all the wealth of His 'conversion'... to man. This conversion is a Grace.

An effort of understanding, of heart and of will, is also indispensable for accepting Grace. It is indispensable for not losing the Divine dimension of life in the human dimension; [and] for persevering in it." — *Pope John Paul II*
