Dear Parishioners,





If I were asked to condense the eight beatitudes in one sentence, I would suggest this one: Blessed are those who are compassionate as my Father in heaven is compassionate, for his joy will be theirs. What I mean by being compassionate is not what we usually think: somehow looking down in people, having pity on them. No, compassion means to feel what the other person is feeling, to suffer from what he suffers, to rejoice with him about what gives him joy. Compassion enlarges your heart to the dimensions of Christ's heart. Nothing remains foreign to you. Every good thing that happens to someone becomes a source of blessing for you. Every suffering moves you to love more. The whole Christian journey is a journey into compassion until we feel, think and act as our Father in heaven feels, thinks and acts. The last three and a half years , the Lord has given me a lot of opportunities to grow in compassion. Sometimes, I would find it in my heart when I least expected it, as a spring flower pressing through the melting snow.

But the biggest surprise for me was to discover the healing power of compassion as I began to hear more and more confession and do more and more spiritual direction. I was lead to pray for the inner healing of those persons who shared their burdens with me. Whenever I feel a deep compassion for a person, it is a sign to me that God is doing something about that situation. It is a sign that God wants me to join him in his healing words. It is a sign that the Father requests my prayers and is already answering them. The fruit may blossom later but some healing process is undergoing already. This is what was going on in Jesus when he was healing the sick and forgiving the sinner. This is what can happen in your life. Are you ready for the gift? The world needs it very badly!

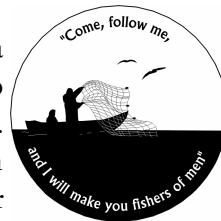

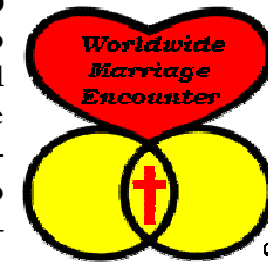
