Baptism of the Lord



Dear Parishioners, on this Feast Day of the Baptism of our Lord, we notice in today's Gospel that the Holy Spirit descended upon our Lord when he was baptized with water. And, that is certainly what our Catholic Catechism teaches about us as well when we too are baptized with water in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. As #'s 1262 and 1268 of the Catholic Catechism tells us, "the two principal effects [of baptism] are purification from sins and *new birth in the Holy Spirit,*" and that God also gives us "*the power to live and act under the prompting of the Holy Spirit through the gifts of the Holy Spirit.*" What does this say but that baptism implies that we are *born again anew, to live our Christian lives in the power of the Holy Spirit.*

Given these wonder filled realities that result from baptism, how is it then that many of us Catholics still live out our faith in a rather lacklustre way that, too often, seems indistinguishable from the rest of our Canadian society? This in contrast to what is happening in other parts of the world, especially Africa, where the Catholic Church has grown 6700% in the 20th century alone, no doubt in great part through Catholics living out their faith and sharing their faith to others!

Could it be that part of the answer to the situation of Catholics in Canada may lie in the fact that many of us may still be in the situation of being "*sacramentalized but not evangelized?*" By this I mean that we can go to church every Sunday and partake of the sacraments and yet still not have a lived expression of Christ as source, centre, and summit of our lives. Cardinal Avery Dulles, in a recent article on baptism noted that, "according to the primary Christian documents, salvation comes through *personal faith in Jesus Christ,* followed and signified by sacramental baptism." In other words, it is faith in Jesus Christ that saves, as is signified and expressed by the sacrament of Baptism.

But if parents themselves do not see their Catholic faith as an expression of a lived intimate relationship with Christ, lived out daily in the power of the Holy Spirit, how do we expect them to pass on their Catholic faith to their children? (Contd...)



(Pastors corner contd....) It is no wonder then, that I am told often by young Catholics that they don't go to Church regularly because their parents themselves don't go to Church regularly. In other words, Christ isn't all that important in their parents' lives!

As we enter this new year of 2008 then, let us take the opportunity to renew our intimate faith relationship with Christ, through a constant reliance on the Holy Spirit, so that the sacraments that we partake may truly be the source, and lived expression of our faith in our Lord, Jesus Christ.
