Corner


3rd SUNDAY in Ordinary Time January 21st, 2007

Dear Parishioners, God has been working unusual things at St. Mary's since December 20th, 2006. The number of confessions have suddenly multiplied by three or four. We have had hours and hours of confessions and it keeps going. The two weekends after Christmas, we had an average of 8 hours of confessions each weekend. Normally we would have almost no confessions in the following weeks after Christmas.

Not only the number of confessions was unusual, but their quality was very impressive. Fr. Gabriel, Fr. Mark and I were very moved by them. Many beautiful conversions: men and women returning to God and to the Sacraments after a long long time! Many young people too, having long and detailed lists of sins! Who prepared them? We, the pastors did not do anything special, anything different except praying more together and asking people to pray about finding the will of God. All these confessions gave us a sense of the need of many parishioners. So many came to confess a dark secret, a deep wound or a sin they had never been able to confess before. Many mentioned a difficult family situation or a painful workplace. A few shared newly found peace, a sense of intimacy with God. Many tears of joy and repentance!

Why God is doing all this in our parish? Usually, when God pours out his graces to someone, he is calling him or her to a special mission. When God pours out his graces to a group of people, he calls them to a special mission. What is he calling you to do? What is he calling St. Mary's to do? Do not be afraid! His missions are life giving. And he is a great communicator! He is more than willing to tell us what he wants if only we ask him sincerely and regularly. Let us listen to him, in prayer and silence. Be watchful. Look for his invitations. Use those "dead times" during the day, when you are waiting for a green traffic light, for an elevator, or in a line-up for a cashier. At home or in the bus, read the bible, pray the rosary. Share your questions and answers with your pastors and with some trust worthy friends. God Bless you all. Fr. Pierre
