Pastor's Corner

Sunday, July 15th, 2007

Dear Parishioners:

It has been exactly 2 weeks since I have been back from my holidays and it has been for the most part a restful one. Now, it is Fr. Pierre's turn to take his holidays and I also wish him a restful one indeed!

I want to stick to the theme of *holidays* for this week's **Pastor's Corner** precisely because many of us will be taking our holidays very soon if we haven't done so already. Even our Pope is presently on holidays for 2 1/2 weeks in the Italian Alps. First of all, there is good precedent for holidays as we can see Christ and his disciples taking time off to rejuvenate themselves from their hectic ministries. Passages such as *Mark 6.31-32* come to mind where Jesus tells his disciples to "Come away to a deserted place all by yourselves and rest awhile." For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat."

Here is what Pope Benedict recently had to say about the virtue of holidays. He said that holidays are a "gift of God...that allows one to revive the physical and spiritual energies necessary for life's journey." Quoting St. Bernard of Clairvaux, our Pope tells us that working too hard can be bad for the spirit, "...watch out for the dangers of an excessive activity, whatever...the job that you hold, because many jobs often lead to the 'hardening of the heart,' as well as 'suffering of the spirit..."

There is so much truth to St. Bernard's observations especially today when oftentimes the nature of work ends up taking us away from precious little time with family and loved ones, so much so that we become resentful! This is so as "work" becomes more and more influenced by "market forces" that work to the detriment of other aspects of our familial and personal relationships! Only a few weeks ago, a parishioner sadly told me that he will be transferred to another city by his company, while his immediate family stays on in Vancouver! How is this supposed to foster the family? Certainly religions, and especially Christianity, need to be in dialogue with our "market driven" society so as to attempt to, once again, humanize the work place!

Meanwhile, it is *holidays* that we turn to, precisely to renew and strengthen those familial ties, and not only that, but, hopefully, our ties as well with God and nature. Allow me to end with a quote from Pope Benedict, who wishes all, "especially those most in need, the possibility of taking a little vacation to reinvigorate your physical and spiritual energies and recover a salutary contact with nature." My sentiments exactly! Happy summer holidays to you. *God bless, Fr. Mark.*
