Third Sunday in Lent

The monthly missalette Magnificat, which I heartily recommend, introduces today's Gospel about the purification of the Temple with these words:

Fallen human nature always attempts to define the meaning of life with something we can measure. That is what the presence of the moneychangers at the temple symbolizes. Their atrocious activity in the most sacred place betrays their bankrupt position toward the meaning of life. They prefer the riches of God over a relationship with God.

The tendency to define the meaning of life with something we can measure is very dominant in our technological society. The number of things we possess -- cars, TVs, houses -- the money we earn, the influence we have over people, all these measurable things tend to define our achievement and our identity. We are living out a global ideology that could be called "technopoly" as J.S. Porter explains in Sacred Journey --Daily Reflections for Lent 2009. Technopoly is "a society that is not only governed by technological concerns, but also a society whose highest aspirations fall within a technological sphere. In simple English, technopoly has to do with the production of wealth made possible by business computers and the protection of that wealth by military-computer technologies. In a society in which the technological way of being has a monopoly on the expression of the human -- in other words, in a technopoly -- what makes money and what protects it makes the only rational sense. In such a society, the monk, in his refusal to worship dollars or success, presents a radically alternative way of being in the world" (J. S. Porter) God Bless You **Fr. Pierre**
