"Take the Challenge"



Dear Parishioners, "Out of her poverty, this widow has put in everything she had, all she had to live on." (From the Gospel of Mark, 12:44).

Jesus, in giving her as a model, doesn't want us to become homeless beggars. What he admires in her is her immense gratitude to God. She wants to repay him. She knows it is impossible. Yet she does the best she can by giving him all she has to live on. This is her way of expressing her consecration to God. We also are called to repay the Lord lovingly, by consecrating our time, talents and treasures to him. Let us ask the Lord "to produce in us the splendor of a purity of life, the splendor of a capacity for poverty, which is not having any money, but being able to use it for what is greater than we." (Mggr. Guissani)

If you accept this challenge of consecrating your life to the Lord, your very life with all its time, talents and treasures, then the possibilities of human and spiritual growth will flourish in ways you never dreamed off! Your future will start to glow. Things and "coincidences" will start to happen in your life. Your attitudes will change and support you in your daily life. Pieces of your life that you are struggling with, will come together like a puzzle resolved. You will never walk alone (John 16:32). You will see in them hidden virtues that you never saw before, because you will no longer be in competition with them, or envious. Your presence will draw out the goodness of those you walk with. You will let go of the energy-sapping habit of controlling others. You will become tolerant over the non-essentials.

"Seek the Kingdom first and all these things will be given you" (Mathew 6:33). Are you willing to pay to pay the cost? Are you willing to live a life of sacrificial giving, in time, treasures and talents. If you do, only the first steps will be difficult. When you start to pay the cost, you will find that you have a lot more "money", time, talents and treasures, than you thought. (Contd....)

DAILY MORNING PRAYER WITH THE DOMINICANS

In many parishes, the pastor says the morning prayer, called Lauds, with his parishioners before or after daily Mass. This custom was highly encouraged by late pope John Paul II. Lauds is an important part of the daily prayers that all religious and priests say everyday in union with Christ. For more than a thousand years, Lauds and the other hours of the Liturgy, have been a central action of the whole Church. More and more lay people are praying the liturgy of the hours.



At St. Mary's, we have this odd situation where some parishioners pray Lauds in the Church at 7:15am, while the pastors and Dominican Fathers, pray the same Lauds, in their home at 7:30am. **Starting from Tuesday, Nov. 21**, the Dominican Fathers will join the parishioners present at 7:30am in the Church to pray Lauds.

Fr. Gabriel OP, will help us to make this prayer beautiful by leading us into singing. Those of you who pray the rosary at 7:30am, are requested to start earlier, at 7:10am. We are sorry for this inconvenience. We hope you will be rewarded by a blessed prayer. God bless, *Fr. Pierre*.
