**“HE IS SO GOOD, AND NOT EVEN CATHOLIC”**

*“Pious persons can often say something like ‘That person is so good, and not even Catholic!’ When we say something like this we restrict God’s grace, we restrict God’s presence, and we put ourselves on a special pedestal.” (J Donders in With Hearts On Fire.) It is as if we and those of our company were the best in the world!*

The apostle John had this kind of arrogance before Jesus’ death. He wanted the fire of heaven to strike down the Samaritans who did not welcome Jesus. He wanted to be at the right side of Jesus on the day of his enthronement. In today’s Gospel, he says to Jesus, “Teacher, we saw a man who is not one of us driving out demons in your name, and because he is not one of us, we tried to stop him.”

Cardinal Hans Urs von Balthasar reminds us that the Holy Spirit can act through anyone He chooses, Catholic or not Catholic. He writes:

*“The limits one would like to burden the Spirit with do not matter to him, who “blows where he will” (Jn 3:8). His order does not always coincide with the Church’s order, even though he himself prescribes the ecclesial order that the Church has to follow. Nor dare the Church turn the spirit’s freedoms into rules for her own privileges and tolerances. God’s thoughts are high above man’s thoughts, which must follow God’s instructions.” (from Light of the World)*

It is for the Church to obey the Spirit, not for the Spirit to obey the Church.
