**“For when two or three meet in my name,
I shall be there with them”**

Dear Parishioners,

Fr. Joseph Dondeer wrote this in his book, “With Hearts On Fire” (Twenty-Third Publications):

“It happened regularly, and yet I was surprised every time. I was accustomed to prayer. I prayed a lot with my family at home. In those days we went to church every day of the week. I prayed by myself, and later on with the community of missionaries I belong to. We would sit in the chapel for hours and hours a day, meditating, examining our consciences, celebrating the Eucharist, and even preparing for death!

Yet, I was surprised by it once I got to Africa. Practically every time I was invited to a family, celebrated one or another occasion together, visited a sick person, or was invited for a cup of tea, my hosts would ask me to pray together with them. I often forgot. I would already be at the door, shaking hands and saying ‘God bless you’, when my friends would say: ‘Aren’t we going to pray together?’ And that is what we did., sometimes with only two or three, sometimes in a family.

I once read a report written by a student evaluating his pastoral experience in one of the West Indian Islands. He mentioned the same kind of experience. Once he had been awakened in the middle of the night by someone who was obviously disturbed. After a terrible nightmare she had gone to the rectory to knock on the door for help. He didn’t know what to do. Should he give her something to eat, to drink? She saw his consternation, and she said: ‘I don’t need anything. I only came to pray together with you for a moment. I am alone at home.’

He did, and while the two were praying her anxiety disappeared. In Jesus’ presence her anxiety cleared.

(continued) Jesus promised: “When two or three are gathered in my name, I will be there with them.”

If you have a nightmare, please don’t wake me up! I am not holy like Fr. Joe Cuddy, who did answer nightmare calls... but then he died awfully young!

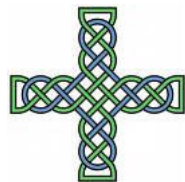
MIRACLE HOUR OF PRAYER
