Pastor's Corner

WHEN MARRIAGE FAILS, THE CHURCH FAILS

It happened in Quebec. Which failure came first? We don't know for sure, but there was a strong correlation between the high rate of divorce and the low church attendance, and also the high rate of teenage suicides.

Of course I am speaking of collectivities not of individuals. Some of you are separated, and are receiving graces upon graces from the Lord, and are bearing much fruit for your families and for the Church. Many saints started in life with a terrible marriage. Many came from dysfunctional families. God can turn every evil into an occasion of grace and holiness. But statistically speaking there is a connection between marriage failure and low church participation. Which one is the cause of the other is hard to tell. When the spouses are angry at each other, envious, jealous, arrogant, and resentful or selfish, it becomes very hard for them to pray and to give the witnessing of a joy-giving faith to their children and grandchildren, to their workplaces, to their social and religious groups. Their kids tend to doubt, sometimes unconsciously, the goodness of God and His power to overcome evil. Ultimately, they doubt in the institution of marriage. They question the Church's teachings on marriage. Their images of God the Father, Jesus the Brother and Mary the Mother are darkened by their own tumultuous relationship with their dad and mom.

When each of the spouses in turmoil go to work, they bring with them a load of stress and anger. When they try to pray at the Sunday mass, worries bar the way. A hidden anger at God makes it difficult for them to have a personal relationship with Him.

Today we are not only aware that marriage breakdown makes life in society difficult, but we are also aware of the conspiracy of socio-cultural and socio-economic threats against marriage. It almost looks like a conspiracy orchestrated by the evil powers. The devil knows that he has to topple down the institution of marriage and family in order to have free reign on us. (con't...)

The communist party in Eastern Europe knew that. Today marriage is under attack by the economy, the politics, the workplace, the universities, by pornography in all its forms and even by some so-called Christian churches. Are we going to do something about it?
