**Pastor's
 Corner**

THE PERILS OF THE SHEPHERD

He was a professional mountain guide. I met him on a hike through the French Alps. I asked him to tell me about his scariest experience; "Once, he answered, I was walking on a high altitude glacier. I felt deep down a narrow crevasse. My fall stopped at a place near the crevasse that was too narrow for my body. I could not do anything. My companions up there threw me a rope, but it was not long enough to reach me. I was many hundred feet down! They had to call for a helicopter to bring a rope long enough. I waited all night long for it. At each cracking sound of the glacier I was afraid to be crushed to death or to sink down further. I could not do anything to get warm. I thought I would die. Finally the rope did come down."

This story reminds me of Christ who had to go down in deepest loneliness of human life in order to find the "lost sheep", that I am, that you are. He will go down as low as the lowest of us is; like the mother eagle who dives into the abyss to catch her little one who is falling down.

Pope Benedict wrote in 1994 that *"the temptations (of Jesus) are a descent into the perils besetting mankind, for there is no other way to lift up fallen humanity. Jesus had to enter into the drama of human existence, for that belongs to the core of his mission; he has to penetrate it completely, down to its uttermost depths in order to find the "lost sheep, to bear it on His shoulders and to bring it home". (Magnificat)*

When we have a big temptation we feel horrible. We feel unworthy. The holier we are, the worse it feels. Christ, the only truly Holy one, felt the temptation of rebellion and hatred. He, whose very essence is to love the Father's will, felt a temptation that was totally contrary to it. He, who is one with the Father, felt that he was abandoned by the Father. He felt like us and at a much deeper level, when we are really tempted to doubt the Father's love. The devil kept saying to Jesus, (cont'd)

"You think you are the Son of God. But if God was really your Father, He would not ask you to walk to Calvary".

"Through the temptations in the desert Jesus is brought to a life or death awareness of the absolute primacy of his union with His Father. He undergoes these temptations so that we can embrace his own conviction. Our temptations are moments of grace moving us to call on the name of the Lord in our powerlessness and weakness so that we will be saved. The Lord enriches all who call upon him by drawing them to share his union of love with his Father (Magnificat).

- *We are deep in the glacier's crevasse!*
- *The Church is the rope that reaches down to us.*
- *Christ is holding the rope.*
- *The Father is the helicopter lifting up Christ, the Church and us.*
