Pastor's Corner

STOP COLLECTING ROCKS!

Rachel's Vineyard is a retreat for women and men who have been involved in abortion. It is a powerful way to be free of the burden of guilt and to start living. At the beginning of the retreat, the participants are given a heavy rock which symbolizes their personal guilt. They are to carry it everywhere and at all times, whether they are inside or outside. They even have to take their meals with it, and take it in the shower too!

After a while, they realize how their guilt is preventing them from being attentive and efficient while doing their daily chores. When they are ready, at any time during the retreat, they can get rid of their guilt; of the rock. They have to invent their own way of doing it. Some throw the rock off a cliff; some place it on the altar at the beginning of mass.

At one point, they act out today's Gospel about the woman caught in adultery. It is not difficult for them to play the role of the adulterous woman, caught in the middle of a closed circle formed by men. Then each of them get to play the role of the accusers. They indeed have their rock, their guilt that they can use to throw at the woman who is being accused. They feel the temptation of using their own personal guilt as a weapon to stone another person like themselves. They also get a chance to play the role of Jesus who forgives and who has no rock, no stone. Later they share their discoveries.

This is so much like real life. The more we are loaded with guilt, even unconscious feelings of guilt, the more we tend to accuse others, to presume bad intentions in their heart, even when they do good. There is one way to stop accusing and to start living in communion with others: it is to give our guilt to Christ. Let us do that this week at the sacrament of reconciliation, Wednesday the 24th of March at St. Mary's Church, after the 7:00pm mass. We will be six priests, collecting rocks for *Iesus*.
