MOTHER TERESA AND THE YOUNG MAN

Last week, a young man I had never seen before spent ninety minutes debating with me three questions. First, "what is the meaning of life?" My life, he said, is just work. I don't enjoy life. I wish my mother had aborted me. The second question was, "Why doesn't God speak to me anymore? I pray and he never answers. I am talking to a wall." The third question was "How can I know God is real? The world is such a mess. How can I be sure of Christ's teachings and of his church?"

Mother Teresa would answer his first question about the meaning of life by these words: "To me, Jesus is the Life I want to live, the Light I want to reflect, the Way to the Father, the Love I want to express, the joy I want to share, the Peace I want to sow around me. Jesus is everything to me."

Again Mother Teresa would answer his second question about the silence of God in words similar to these: "God is crying to you 'I thirst' through the cries of your spouse, children, family, co workers. Christ is telling you, "I was naked, sick, hungry and you did not clothe me, nurse me, feed me." Don't wait for a private revelation during your prayer time. Listen to the cries of his people and he will talk to you.

To the third question about how we can know that Christ is real and alive and that his Church really speaks His words, St. Augustine would answer, "If you want to experience God, love your neighbour as He has loved you, dying to yourself everyday. Then look at that love in your heart. That love is from God, is God, for God is love." Cardinal Balthasar would answer: "By this [by loving one another as Christ has loved you] and only by this, no other characteristic of the Church can convince the world of the rightness and necessity of Christ's person and teaching. Radiant love lived by Christians is the proof of all teaching, dogmas, and moral precepts of the Church of Christ."

Mother Teresa would also answer: 'If faith is scarce, it is because there is too much selfishness in the world, too much egoism. Faith, in order to be authentic, has to be generous and giving. Love and faith go hand in hand..."
