WHAT DOES REAL LIFE HAVE TO DO WITH IT?

Last month I met someone who had never brought his real life to confession. He said that he never thought religion and real life had anything to do with each other. Therefore a priest could not help him to deal with his real life. Indeed the Church seems to many people to be emptied from human life. It performs lifeless rituals and teaches rigid laws about what you should not do if you want to live in another world after death! This is not what the Church should be about, this is how it is perceived. We, Catholics, have to change that perception and that reality!

To achieve this, we must bring our real life to the Church, and we must bring the real life of the Church to the world. First, we must bring our whole life to Christ! We must let Christ know us through and through, forgive us, heal us, transform us. This is done not only by the confession but by studying the Scriptures with the community, receiving anew the power of the Holy Spirit, serving and loving one another, sharing our faith and love within the Church. "There is nothing more beautiful than to be surprised by the Gospel, by the encounter with Christ. There is nothing more beautiful than to know him and to speak to others of our friendship with him." (Pope Benedict)

You will not be able to contain the joy of this friendship within the walls of St. Mary's Church. You will want to give freely what you have freely received. Evangelization is a beggar telling another beggar where he has found bread! "Evangelization is not only accomplished through public preaching of the Gospel (...) but also by means of personal witness which is always very effective in spreading the Gospel." (Congregation for the Doctrine of Faith, Rome)
