THE METAPHYSICAL JOURNEY— ASCENSION

We sometimes imagine the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ in a hyper-realistic way: Jesus beginning a journey into space until He reaches a place called heaven. But even if Jesus had been traveling at the speed of light, He would be barely going out of our galaxy, two thousand years later, that is now. And He would still have to go through millions, billions of other galaxies. What we celebrate today is not that Christ has gone into a physically different place— He said He would be with us every day until the end of time, but that His whole being, including His body, His human nature, has entered into another metaphysical dimension, a way of being that shares God's way of being. We know that one day, we too will have a body like His.

What do I mean by all this? That Christ, at the Ascension, is no longer limited by the space-time matrix, even in His body. We live in space and time. We can only be present in one place at a time. And so did Jesus before His Resurrection. When He was in Jerusalem, He could not be physically present in Galilee. Now He can, even physically. Because He has a spiritual body, as Paul describes. He shares in His Resurrected Body, God's way of being present everywhere, of knowing everything about every one of us, of being in relation to all and each of us at the same time. We will be like that in heaven, after the Resurrection of the dead.

We see anticipation of that in the lives of the saints. Padre Pio, who died in the twentieth century, had the gift of bilocation several times. Also, in near-death experience, people in comas have experienced a form of out-of-the-body consciousness. We don't have to believe in these experiences of near-death, but they could be used to open our minds to a different mode of knowing and perceiving that transcends the limit of time and space.

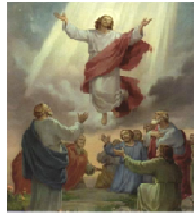

The Ascension makes the Eucharist possible. Christ can be physically present in every consecrated host of the universe, because it is His Risen Body that is present in the consecrated bread, a Body that has joined the qualities of the spiritual and the physical realm.

This is also what we mean when we pray the Our Father with Jesus: "Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done here as it is in heaven." When we say that, we pray that the day will come, when the dynamics of relationship with one another and with God will be the same here as they are in heaven, in God's sphere of being.
