Dear Parishioners,

Following in the footsteps of Fr. Pierre in last Sunday's *Pastor's Corner*, I thought I would take this opportunity to write a few words of introduction myself, being that this is the very first *Pastor's Corner* that I have written since my ordination to the Priesthood two years ago in this very parish of St. Mary's.



First of all, I want to say that like many of you, I too will be saddened by the departure of Fr. Guy for Taiwan. Fr. Guy was my first Student Director while I was studying for the Dominican Order in Ottawa. Guy is leaving us with, and that is a parish community that continues to be more eager for evangelization, faith education, community life, and social justice.
