Pastor's Corner

28th SUNDAY In Ordinary Time October 15th, 2006 Shelter or Prison? Possessions or Obsessions?



(Contd...)

Dear Parishioners, For the longest time, I had a feeling that something was missing in my life. I could not pinpoint it. God was there, but not really there. I was good, but not that good. I knew I was missing a joy and a peace that come from above. But how to get it? At one point, the Holy Spirit began to enkindle my prayer life and slowly showed me, in the midst of my daily activities and prayers, that the real problem was not something lacking, but something too much! Possessions, attachment to things, attitudes, mind sets, bad habits. I had unconsciously believed all these things were necessary to protect me, but they were cutting me away from true life, true relationships, true joy. Far from being protective, these things were hurting me and hurting others. Through them, I was putting Christ to death again and again. These "security" devices, far from protecting me, were forms of passive aggression and active retaliation.

The following lines, borrowed from the great Patriarch Athenagoras, exemplify what I am talking about:

We need to succeed in disarming ourselves.

I have fought this war. For years and years. It was terrible.

But now I'm disarmed.

I am no longer afraid of anything, because "love drives out fear."

I am disarmed of the will to overcome,

to justify myself at the expense of others.

I am no longer on the alert, jealously grasping my riches.

I welcome and I share. I am not attached to my opinions, to my plans.

If other better proposals come to me, I accept them willingly.

Or rather, not better, but good. You know, I have given up comparisons..

That which is good, true, real, wherever it is, it is the best for me.

Therefore, I am no longer afraid.

When you no longer possess anything, you no longer have fear.

"Who can separate us from the love of Christ?"

But if we disarm ourselves, if we divest ourselves, if we open ourselves to the God-man who makes all things new, then it is he who cancels our evil past and gives back to us a new time where everything is possible.

God can do the same thing for you. Ask him what is the first step you have to take. He will do ninety percent of the work. The first step is the most difficult. Once you have started, you will not want to look back anymore.

ST. MARY'S YOUNG ADULT GROUP (SMYAC) - (Ages 18 - 39)


Karaoke Night - Fri. Oct 20, 8pm.

In the School Gym. We have an assortment of indoor sporting activities all lined up just for you. Come for an afternoon of full of awesome games. Keep fit and have fun!




CWL - SENIORS SAFETY AND CRIME PREVENTION TALK
