# Sunday, July 1st, 2007

Dear Parishioners, Many of us will have our vacation during this month of July. It is a good opportunity to practice living the present moment.

Jesus says, "Do not look back at your past, it would prevent you from heading in the right direction." This is so true. Have you ever tried to ride a bicycle while looking backward? You end up swerving to the left or the right; you cannot ride straight unless you look forward. Same with life.

We are sometimes obsessed with getting even with people who have hurt us in the past. If we try to get even, we cannot get ahead! We ruin our vacation time, or even our life, trying to undo the past and reconstruct it in our imagination. We say to ourselves, "I should have answered him this or that; I should have reacted this or that way." But we cannot really reshape the past.

We may also be obsessed with the things and persons we had to leave because of our choice. And this prevents us from being committed to the present. For example, we may miss our native country and always compare life in Canada with the life we had in our former homeland. We may so regret our former girlfriend or boyfriend that we cannot see the goodness of our present spouse.

If we are to choose Christ, we need to let go of our sinful past and accept the new life-style of the Holy Gospel. We may have to "burn our ships" to avoid the temptation of sailing back to the past. Elisha burned his farming equipment in order to follow the call of God. Of course, you don't have to burn your belongings to follow Christ. But you must be ready to leave everything behind. If you don't have this radical commitment you won't enjoy the freedom of serving God. It took me a lot of time to commit my life to Christ. I really did it not many years ago. Don't wait that long. You may be wasting your life and going astray because you are holding on to the past.
