Dear Parishioners, The writer of the Gospel of



Luke focuses on the redemption of humankind with a particular emphasis on care of the poor and the oppressed. Right from the beginning with the birth narrative of Jesus, a new life-giving history begins. In the scripture readings this week, at the conclusion of the book of Isaiah, we learn that God is merciful and is going to bring about peace and restoration to Jerusalem and to the people. And St. Paul, at the end of his letter to the Galatians, makes the claim that it is by Christ and through his people that a new creation is accomplished.

Now this sounds awesome, at least up to the part that requires yours' and my participation! How in the midst of the demands of our busy lives are we to participate in creating a more humane and peaceful world?

Christ Jesus hears our needs and acts compassionately - forgiving, strengthening, guiding, providing, and comforting us. Through Christ's self-giving love, our dignity, energy, and hope are restored. So great is our joy and thanksgiving for God's acts of empathy and compassion on our behalf, that in-turn, we can sing as we did last Sunday: "Let there be Peace in the world and let it begin with me."





If you are wondering how to get started at contributing to a new creation, you might like to first reflect prayerfully about what it is that you despair about in your church, community or world. This will help you identify where the world might benefit from your help. Is your concern: child hunger, aids, family health, literacy, or violence? When you have clarity about what despair you hold, look to see what God is doing in the world that relates to it. Go and offer your gifts and talents to God in that place.

Where our love and resources through Christ are submitted for the well being of one another, and where our faith in God grows as a result, we can trust that we are participating in the making of God's new creation.

THE RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

It is a part of the provincial housing strategy, Housing Matters BC, and offers direct cash assistance to eligible families who rent in the private market. On March 1, the Government of British Columbia introduced enhancements to the Rental Assistance Program, which expands eligibility and assistance for low-income, working families. Due to these changes, families who have a gross household income less than \$28,000 may now be eligible. Families must have at least one child under the age of 19, have lived in BC for the past 12 months, and have been employed at some point during the past year. 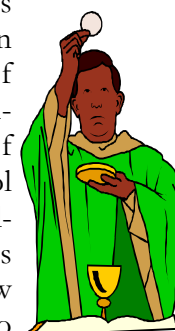
