Dear Parishioners,

I am sure that we are all aware of the danger of environmental pollution and, among other things, of our absolute need for oxygen to sustain life. Without oxygen, no living organism could ever live. Exactly the same might be said about the deadly effects of sin in our lives as Catholic Christians. I have no doubt that sin, in the lives of the individual as well as that of our societies, does have a dire effect on the physical deterioration of the environment of our planet. The good news is that one of the greatest antidotes and vaccines against sin is prayer, personal and liturgical. As a matter of fact, many a spiritual author has called prayer the oxygen of Christian life. As the depletion of oxygen in the physical world leads to the death of life, likewise the neglect or the absence or the rejection of prayer in our lives ultimately results in the death of our spiritual life. Prayer is a must, a necessity, a privilege and a joy for all of us who have experienced the treasure of our baptismal faith in Jesus Christ, our Lord, Saviour and God. When prayer is neglected or abandoned, faith is blurred, confused and eventually destroyed. Why so? Because faith and prayer are a couple that cannot be separated: what or rather whom you pray to determines the content and the depth of your faith (the "lectio orandi" is the "lectio credendi"). Today's Gospel of Luke emphasises the utter importance of prayer: "Ask, and it will be given you; search, and you will find, knock, and the door will be opened... If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"

Let us ask then in our daily prayer for the Gift of the Holy Spirit. It is in Him that we can truly say and confess that "Jesus is Lord". It is through Jesus our Lord that we enter into deep intimacy with our loving Father and say to Him "Abba" (*daddy*). This is the experience of the Virgin Mary, our Blessed Mother and of all the Saints. So let us all and each one of us breathe deeply the oxygen of life in Christ and truly rediscover the power of prayer! *Fr. Gabriel OP*
