Pastor's Corner

Sunday September 23rd, 2007



Dear Parishioners,

A few days ago, a parishioner was lamenting the fact that the flowers that she had planted in her yard, and was so proud of, was dug up and stolen from her the next day.

And, here is another incident, a couple of weeks back another parishioner lost a ring at St. Mary's that was very precious to him. It was very precious not so much because it was a diamond ring, although it was that too, but much more so because it was a ring given to him on his 50th birthday by his beloved wife – imagine having to tell his wife that the ring was now lost forever! A week later, he received an envelope through the parish office, and, low and behold, upon opening the envelope, what did he find inside but that diamond ring! Clearly an honest soul who strives to live out his/her (?) Christian faith had *anony-mously* returned the ring to the owner. You can imagine how thankful he was, especially not having to face his wife with the news that her precious birthday gift was now gone forever!

I thought it opportune to share these two incidents to you for several reasons: The first is to publicly thank that good and honest parishioner for his/her (?) actions. It is clear that, that anonymous parishioner has put his/her (?) Christian faith into action, and not just empty words! The second is that besides such actions being blessed by God, the anonymous parishioner has contributed, as a Christian, to cultivating a humane and civilized society where the dignity of the human person, as created in the image and likeness of God, is considered with respect. Why? Because that parishioner returned that expensive ring without expecting anything in return! Such a life lived, and such actions certainly go contrary to the life of whomever it was that stole the flowers from the garden. Where the one respects the dignity of the human person, the other doesn't! You can just imagine how such reckless disrespect of the life of another, when practiced by many, can take us as a society over time! Today's Gospel calls attention to our need to be discerning of what it means to call ourselves Christians. Does it mean one that allows us to take advantage of our neighbour while yet calling ourselves Christians? Or does it mean one who, like God, contributes to the continual up-building of human life as deserving of respect from the moment of conception to its natural end? Surely, God withholds His blessings from the former while showering His blessings upon the latter!
