I had thought my belief in life after death was unshakable. I was familiar with the stories of martyrs who had walked joyfully towards their death. Their death was not merely something <u>done</u> to them. It was their ultimate act of self-giving to God. Our own death can be shaped with the same Spirit, patterned after the death and Resurrection of Christ. We will receive the grace for this, in due time.

But, last Tuesday, at the grave of my friend Robert, looking at the dark hole about to receive his body, my assurances were shaken. That old doubt, that old question came back, fiercely. Fifty years ago, when my grandmother died, I had stopped believing in eternal life and in the goodness of God. I could not believe in a God who would let my grandma die the way she did.

As I am writing this, another Easter comes to my mind. It was forty-seven years ago, three years after my grandma's death. I had become a sixteen year old agnostic, cynical and arrogant. If there even was a God, it could not possibly be the God of the Church. It was 10:00pm on Holy Saturday. My good friend Réjean wanted to bring me to the Cathedral for the midnight Easter Mass. He knew I was not going to church anymore so he enticed me with his motorcycle. We would slice through ten kilometres of Montréal traffic at around ninety kilometre per hour. That appealed to me enough to face the long mass that would follow. So I went ... just for the motorcycle ride.

During the mass, the God of Easter became so real to me that I could hardly leave the cathedral. My friend had to pull me out. Staying in the church became better than a motorcycle ride! Forty-seven years later I still connect with this grace, and many others that came after that one. The illusion to avoid is not the belief in eternal life in and through Christ. The illusion to avoid is that the tomb is the end of all life: this is what the enemy wants us to believe, because then he could manipulate us into fear and hatred. Happy Easter *Fr. Pierre*
