CAN I CONTINUE TO LOVE HIM AFTER WHAT HE DID?

The answer to that question is closely related to another question" "Can God continue to love me after what I have done?" How often have I heard confessions where the penitent "was so ashamed of his sins to the point that he didn't think God could continue to love him?" (Fr. R. Veras in Magnificat). That penitent may have known in his <u>head</u> that his sins were nothing compared to God's <u>infinite</u> love, but he could not believe it in his <u>heart</u>. Why?

It has to do with our human experience of love. We experience that the more we love someone, the more we can be hurt by his/her lack of love, by his/her self-centeredness. Therefore it is more difficult to forgive him/her. From this we conclude that when we hurt or sin against someone who loves us greatly, like God, that person cannot continue to love us in the same way, even if he "forgives". Sadly enough, this is often true at the human level. But with the grace of Jesus Christ, we can overcome the natural reaction to our hurts and really love more the person who has offended us. How much more is this true for Jesus Christ Himself?! He is the Divine Source of Forgiveness, the Divine Mercy in person!

This is a great mystery! God is more "wounded" by our lack of love than anyone else, because He is Love, because He loves us more than anyone else... infinitely more! Yet he can forgive us immediately and totally, from the bottom of His heart, because of the very nature of His infinite Love. Fr. M.D. Philippe, OP expresses this very beautifully in Magnificat.

God in the fullness of his love, is the most vulnerable of beings, the being in whom there is no hardness, or egoism, or bitter, cold, indifferent return into himself, for he is love. It is truly love which makes us attentive to others, to live what they live. God in his whole personality, is love. Hence in his whole personality, he is receptive. He is one who draws us to himself, and wishes to hide us in the very mystery of his love. (next page)

Do you want to forgive? Ask Christ to give you His forgiveness so that you may forgive your spouse, parent, child friend, with His forgiveness. Ask for the forgiveness that was in His heart on the Cross, when He said "Father, forgive them for they do not know what they are doing." Ask that this forgiveness come down from the Cross into your heart. He will change your heart of stone into a heart of flesh ... His heart of flesh. Happy Divine Mercy Sunday, *Fr. Pierre*
