Jesus said, "I will not leave you orphaned... you will know that I am in my Father and you in me, and me in you." (John 14:18&20). How do we know that Jesus abides in us and we in Him? We know it when we accept everything that life throws at us, with a big inner smile, because we know it is given or permitted by God. For example, we obey our superiors, not because of fear, but because of God, because it is our God-given duty. We accept trials, sufferings and diseases because God gave permission for these to happen and because we know that God will give us the strength to deal with them and may even heal us in due time.

We know that God is in us and we in God when we adhere with all our will and strength to all circumstances in our lives as if we were adhering to God himself and embracing Him through them. Then we find ourselves resting in the embrace of God's love.

It is not always easy! Fr. Henri Nouwen, one of the most famous spiritual writers shares his struggles, even at the end of his life, "The anxiety that has plagued me during this last week shows that a great part of me is not yet 'abiding' in Jesus. My mind and heart keep running away from my true dwelling place, and they explore strange lands where I end up in anger, resentment, lust, fear and anguish. I know that living in a spiritual life means bringing every part of myself home to where it belongs..."

Jesus keeps saying, "Come back to me, give me all your burdens, all your worries, fears and anxieties. Trust that with me you will find rest." I am struggling to listen to that voice of love and to trust in its healing power. I deeply know that I have a home in Jesus, just as Jesus has a home in God."
