**"Drinking the Water of Life"**

Dear Parishioners, this Sunday's Gospel is about the Samaritan woman at the well whom Jesus offers the *water of life*, and this while knowing fully her rather colourful background. In a lot of ways the life of the Samaritan woman in today's Gospel reflects many of our lives as well, doesn't it? Many of us oftentimes look to other things in life to try to fulfill the emptiness in us. It may be clothes, shopping, gambling, drinking, pornography, power, money, whatever. As for the Samaritan woman, it was likely the string of husbands that she had, one after the other, like some of the Hollywood starlets! Yet, for those of us who have delved into any or perhaps even all of such things, we find that they bring us only further emptiness in the end, don't they? Well, initially they may keep us interested, but only for a short while. After that, that inner emptiness and inner hunger floats to the surface once again, and there arises once again a deep yearning for further meaning and fulfillment in life. This must have been the case for that Samaritan woman, as she was walking towards the well that hot fateful day. She must have been asking herself where did she go wrong in life? Is there meaning in life after all? Why is it that after going through all those men in her life, she hasn't yet found that deep fulfillment she is seeking for?



In today's Gospel, we see Jesus reaching out to us as well, no matter where we presently are in our own personal lives. Jesus reaches out to us to offer *the water of life* to quench the deep thirst and yearning for ultimate meaning in our own lives. This *water of life* that is then meant to bring about conversion and transformation in our own lives leading to eternal union with God! Notice what Jesus, himself, says to the Samaritan woman, "the water that I will give will become...a spring of water gushing up to eternal life." In other words, when we receive this *water of life*, when we dare in faith, even in our present circumstances, to receive Jesus personally into our lives and hearts, he gives us the meaning we yearn for, the meaning that is God and His profound love in our lives. (Pastors corner contd..) The meaning that hopefully then leads to further conversion and transformation in our lives, so that one day, we indeed will come to this ultimate and eternal union with God.

If there is this deep desire in you to have your thirst quenched, to find the meaning in life that you have been searching and yearning for all these years, then go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and then take a moment of quiet to slowly say out loud this prayer to our Lord Jesus Christ:

*Lord Jesus Christ, I surrender my life to You. I ask for forgiveness for the area(s) of my life that has kept me from you. I thirst for you, my Lord, and I want a deep and intimate relationship with you. I ask in faith that you come into my life in a personal way and transform my life with your love, your forgiveness, and your healing, into eternal life. Amen.*

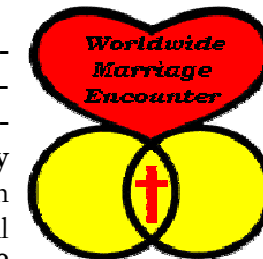
