# Second Sunday in Lent SURRENDER YOUR CHILDREN?

The biggest cross most parents and grandparents have, is to powerlessly watch their teenaged children and their young adult sons and daughters go astray and stay away from the church. Their grandchildren are not baptized, they know nothing about Christ. Their sons and daughters have gone through several divorces and remarriages. Sooner or later, before they reach the age of forty-five, the parents come to terms with this crisis and admit that they cannot control the life of their children anymore

To their children in their twenties, they can "only" offer their testimony that they have found joy in living their faith. They cannot impose their faith from the outside. They can and should maintain a good relationship with their children, based on mutual forgiveness, understanding and love. They should affirm their children and give them unconditional love.

But they have to surrender them to God. This was the test given to Abraham by God. Abraham was asked to surrender completely his only son, Isaac, to Him. Now, Abraham had left his country and family to follow God, when he was already in his seventies. For the next two or three decades, he was promised a son who would be the father of a great nation. When he finally had a son, he was asked to sacrifice him. God stopped Abraham short of killing his son. He did tell him that He did not want human sacrifice. But Abraham had already surrendered his son in his heart, when he took hold of the knife.

#### Pastor's corner (con't)

Cardinal and theologian Hans Urs von Balthasar wrote:

"The horror of it consists not in the command to kill the son of one's own body -- this was part of surrounding religions and, illicitly, in Israel itself -- rather, the horror lies in the act that this son was miraculously given by God and destined to imitate and accomplish the divine promises. In His command God contradicts himself. Yet though the command may be incomprehensibly contradictory to man, he must obey because God is God."

God Himself did it for us. He gave up His only Son into our criminal hands. And Christ, the Second Person of the Trinity surrendered Himself to the Father
