Jesus' entry into our lives



Dear Parishioners, when Jesus entered Jerusalem the whole city was shaken and asked, "Who is this?" In our day and age, what kind of event would have to occur before the entire city of Vancouver would be so shaken as to ask "who is this?" Would it be the arrival of a rock star or a professional athlete, to offer some excitement? The unexpected death of a major political figure perhaps? Or, more likely, a sudden terrorist invasion, or occupation by some foreign troops? But the arrival of a simple man on a donkey? It is likely not to attract any more attention than a passing glance!

If this is so, then the question arises. What kind of people have we become that only fame, fortune or some kind of disastrous misfortune must happen before we have our attentions grabbed? Perhaps at this point in time, the easiest thing for us to want to do is to turn to the media or whatever, to lay the finger of blame for developing such deadening tendencies in our hearts and souls!

Whatever the case may be, and whoever is to be actually blamed, during this Holy Week let us just take the opportunity to focus on that simple man processing through the streets on a humble donkey and ask ourselves if he would still be able to grab our attention, if we would still be attracted to him, or drawn by him...

What kind of person is this "Jesus" who still has the power to grab my attention so that I can still stand in awe of him, and then allow this awe to turn to 'hosannas'? Who indeed is this person, "Jesus" for me, and why, indeed, do I still want to shout out 'hosanna' from the depths of my being as he passes my way? Or do I want to do so, or indeed, do I even care? These are some of the questions Cackie Upchurch asks us to think about on this Palm Sunday and as we enter into Our Lord's Passion. *God bless, Fr. Mark.*
