Pastor's  
Corner

#### Sunday October 05, 2008

Last Monday, I spent my day off at Third Beach in Stanley Park. The sky was pure and the tide was so low that it cleared a ridge of flat rocks extending far into the bay. I walked right to the end of it and set my beach chair on the highest and most remote flat rock. There I sat, surrounded by beauty as I listened to the Ode to Joy by Beethoven on my portable CD.

Praise filled my heart. I was reading about the archangels Gabriel, Michael and Raphael. God made me understand that praise is the very substance of eternal life and of holiness on earth. The angels in heaven don't want to do anything else as they stand in awe before the face of God. As I gazed on the natural beauty of the North Shore Mountains, the Pacific Ocean and the Sunshine Coast, I felt deeply connected with the praise of angels in heaven, contemplating the Infinite Ocean of God's Beauty, Love and Majesty.

If only I could see God's Presence shining in every event, good or bad -- in any person, beautiful or ugly -- it would already be heaven on earth. But why is it so difficult to praise God "always and everywhere"? It is because praise demands of me that I surrender my self-centeredness. To praise God, I need to let go of my worries and any constant complaining.

In today's letter of Paul to the Philippians, the apostle writes, "Do not worry about anything, but in everything let your requests be known to God by prayer and supplication with **thanksgiving**; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus".

Now St. Paul is not asking us to ignore our worries and needs. He urges us to pray about them and to do something about them. But he warns us to stop the constant negative thinking about them. He proposes us to replace the negative thoughts with positive ones.

*"Finally, beloved, whatever is true, whatever is honourable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is pleasing, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. Keep on doing the things that you have learned and heard and seen in me, and the God of peace will be with you."* Fr. Pierre

#### SPONSOR A STUDENT

Dear Parishioners, As you all know, parents are required to pay tuition for children attending Catholic schools. By and large, the parents of our children at St. Mary's School and our Catholic High Schools are bearing the burden. Sometimes however, the burden becomes impossible to bear, as for example when a single parent loses his or her employment. When this happens, mercy for the child and our obligation to mutual solidarity in the Church demand that we provide tuition aid.

There are limits however, to the amount of tuition aid that we can provide as a parish. Already, the parish provides a hefty subsidy for Catholic education, especially at St. Mary's and Notre-Dame, to which we are committed as "a feeder-parish".

As a partial solution to this dilemma, I am proposing a system of private sponsoring. If you feel strongly about the benefit of Catholic education, and if you are in a position to help a family that has fallen on hard times and cannot, for a time bear alone the cost of tuition, please let me know. Your identity, as well as that of the family you are helping, will remain confidential.

Next Sunday, Oct. 11/12, we will also have a second collection for Student Aid. Please write your name, address and envelope number as well as Student Aid on the envelope when you bring your donation. You will receive a receipt for income tax.
