# Pastor's Corner

#### LOVING LIKE GOD LOVES

The great trials that come inevitably in our lives can either destroy us or build us up. Anyone who has a bit of wisdom can perceive this truth. What many don't see is how God is guiding us, each one of us, so that these trials build us up so that we truly achieve our destiny here on earth and thereafter in heaven. We all need to cooperate with God, "in good times and in bad, for richer and poorer."

Now God is Love. Therefore Love is our guiding principle in all our decisions. But if we want to cope with big trials and cooperate with Love, we need to do it first and foremost in the little day to day trials. Our second reading today, the famous "hymn to love" of St. Paul in Corinthians Chapter 13, is our teacher today. Now we can dismiss Love and today's teaching, if we have the popular view of love: the idea that love is essentially about romantic feelings and/or erotic love. That kind of love isn't bad, but it can't help us deal with the big trials of life as well as the day to day ones. That kind of love has its role and its importance but it's not our primary source of strength in life.

What Paul has in mind here is love that may include feelings and eros, but is deeper. It is the Love that is in God, the Love that God is, and wants to share with us, so that we can be a channel of love for one another. The best example we have of this love is the love of parents for their children. Of course, I don't forget about the love of the saints for the people of God. Saints like Mother Teresa exemplify the love of parents for their children. What is that love; according to the Bible and Church Tradition? To love is to really will the good of the other as other and to act so as to make it happen. Don't worry about this being impossible for you. God's Love has been infused in you by the Holy Spirit. He will help you to let the Love of God and of His children flow in you.

Now we are ready to look at some characteristics of Love in our second reading (Corinthians 13: 4-7).

"Love is patient and kind." If a parent would love his/her child only out of self interest, he/she would not be patient with the child. But a good parent is willing to wait— and wait a long time— for the child's obedient and loving response. Does a parent stop loving his/her child when that child is unresponsive? The parent might be hurt, and displeased but will continue to love. Does a parent love his/her child only when that child listens to him/her and does what is requested? A dysfunctional parent may do that, and we are all dysfunctional at times! But we know we are called to pursue the good of the child effectively. If you love someone only for the return you will get from that person, you will be impatient for the coming of that return. That is a sign that your love for that person might need to be purified.

Real Love, in the image and likeness of God, says, "I have forgiven them, they still haven't forgiven me, but I'll keep forgiving them. I am compassionate to him, he is not to me, but I will keep being compassionate."

"Love is not envious." A parent is not envious about the success of his/her child, or spouse. If you want their good you will rejoice with them when they succeed. You might have a feeling of envy in your heart, but if you don't act according to that feeling, you have not committed any sins. On the contrary, you have gained merits and strength by resisting the temptation to be envious. You are on your way to holiness, wholeness and joy. And God is working in you!
