Pastor's Corner

INTO THE SUN, WITHOUT BURNING!

Can a human being, body and soul, find his way to the Heart of God? Can a human being come so close to the Father as to be in Him? Can you go into the sun without burning? How long would a man survive amidst the extremely intense power and holiness of God? Understanding and believing the mystery of the Ascension of Christ will make it possible to answer these questions positively. On the day of Ascension, Christ with his human nature, that is with his human body, mind, heart and soul, has entered into the Father and invites us to follow Him. "I am going to the Father to prepare a place for you and I will come back and take you to myself so that where I am you also may be. Where I am going, you know the way...I am the way." (John Chapter 14)

Wherever the Christ, the Head of the Body, goes, the Body, that is the Church, ourselves, will follow, if we remain united to Him.

Pope Benedict, quoted in Magnificat, May 2010, explains this in a beautiful manner: "The meaning of Christ's Ascension," writes Pope Benedict XVI, "expresses our belief that in Christ the humanity that we all share has entered into the inner life of God in a new and hitherto unheard of way. It means that man has found an everlasting place in God." It would be a mistake to interpret the Ascension as "the temporary absence of Christ from the world." Rather, "we go to heaven to the extent that we go to Jesus Christ and enter into him." Heaven is a person: "Jesus himself is what we call "heaven."

Are you willing to follow Christ into the Father's Heart? Sometimes we think negatively of heaven: "I will miss my dog, my family, my hobbies, my belongings." Let's think positively of heaven as the fullness of life, as everything that we truly enjoy here but at a higher intensity of being.
