Saint Mary's Parish invites children to Rocky Railway Vacation Bible School: Jesus' Power Pulls Us Through!

A summer kids' event called Rocky Railway VBS will be hosted at Saint Mary's church basement on August 19 to 23 from 9 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. There will be **no** before & after school care. Parents/guardians are asked to drop off and pick up their child according to the camp's operating hours: *Monday doors open 8:30 a.m. and Tuesday to Friday doors open 8:45 a.m. The doors will close at 12:30 p.m.* The cost is \$100 per child.

At Rocky Railway, children learned that Jesus' power pulls us through! Kids participate in memorable Bible-learning activities, sing catchy songs, play teamwork-building games, make and dig into yummy treats (light snacks included – peanut free zone), experience one-of-a-kind Bible adventures, collect Bible Memory Buddies to remind them of Jesus' love, and test out Sciency-Fun Gizmos they'll take home and play with all summer long. Plus, kids will learn to look for evidence of God all around them through something called God Sightings. Each day concludes with Rocky Wrap Up that gets everyone involved in living what they learned. The qualified volunteers have had their references checked, and have basic training in group management and program planning. Some have their first aid certification.
