THE IRRESISTIBLE FREEDOM OF GOD—AND YOURS

Last week, during the Ascension Mass, I was wondering why we stay away from God. Is it fear of intimacy, fear of having to change our life, fear of surrendering?

As I am writing these lines, I remember what Fr. Cantalamessa, the preacher to the papal household said, "There is a secret rancor against God in the depths of man's heart." It was from original sin. It was instilled in the soul of Adam and Eve, by the devil, when they believed him. He told them not to trust God, that God had hidden intentions, selfish intentions, toward them. We inherited the <u>effect</u> of that sin, that anger and resentment toward God and toward one another. As Adam and Eve started to distrust God and hide from him, they also accused one another, and it has never stopped since that day. We blame one another for our problems and the problems of the world. We accuse God. It seems silly to do so, but we do it anyway. We blame God for all the bad things that happen to us. We don't want to admit it, but we are secretly angry at him.

No discourse can change that. No law, no amount of good will can do it. Only the Holy Spirit can wipe away that "secret rancor against God." When the Spirit comes into a man's heart, he attests "that God is truly favourable and benign, that he is his ally, and not his enemy. The Holy Spirit opens his eyes to all that God has been capable of doing for him and to the fact that he did not spare his only Son for him." (Fr. Cantalamessa). "There is a shift in the heart of the man who receives the Spirit. A shift from the slave-heart full of fear to the filial heart, brimming with love." From now on, the man renewed in the Spirit, has received "God's love." He loves God and willingly does what God asks of him. Fr. Cantalamessa even says that "God, in fact, no longer limits himself to telling man what he should do or not do, but he himself does it with and in him."

Saint Thomas Aquinas says that the Holy Spirit interiorly perfects our spirit, communicating to it a new dynamism so that it refrains from evil for love.

That same Holy Spirit does wonders for our human relationship. He turns our Babel towers into a Pentecost where every nation can hear the Word in his own language. He breaks distrust and anger that put man against man.

Fr Mark Link S.J. wrote: "The Spirit gives me:

- new eyes to see the face of Jesus in all who stand in need;
- new ears to hear the voice of Jesus in all who cry to heaven for justice;
- a new tongue to tell the message of Jesus to all who have never really heard it;
- a new heart to share the love of Jesus with all who have never experienced it."
