Every mother in heaven intercedes for her children. Every child in heaven including those who were aborted, intercede for their mother on earth. Why? Because in heaven, everybody there has forgiven everyone on earth. Otherwise, heaven would not be heaven.

I also know that the sooner we can reconcile with our mother, the better it is for her and for ourselves...Sadly enough, I felt for a long time, that a reconciliation with my mother would be a <u>form of abdication of my autonomy</u>, of my true freedom. It was wrong. I knew it. But I could not change it. Only grace can do it. But I had to ask for it.

When we cannot reconcile with our mother, and/or our father, we create a protective barrier around our heart, which prevents life, love and light to come in us and to get out of us. We build a heart of stone and we start judging and accusing those who represent authority and those who represent the power of love and intimacy. We form self-fulfilling curses like "I will never let a woman come close to me", or judgments like "All women are the same". The good news is that, with Christ, we can break these curses, and bring all these judgmental thoughts to the foot of the Cross so that Christ can free us from them. Welcome to a Healing Ministry. Welcome to the Sacrament of reconciliation. I hear some beautiful stories there about relationships with mother and son, mother and daughter. I also hear some tragic stories. Please pray for those who come to confession and for us, priests who hear them.

IGNATIAN SPIRITUAL EXERCISES RETREAT



NOTRE DAME PARISH EDUCATION COMMITTEE


