Pastor's Corner

ONE FLESH!

What was God doing before the creation of the world? Was He not bored, being all alone for eternity? No, He wasn't alone! No, He didn't create us as an amusement, as a video-game to distract Himself, to kill time. Because we imagine God all alone, we tend to see Him as an impersonal force ("The Force be with you"), as an energy, not as a Person. It is impossible for a person to be alone, out of nothing, and for nothing. "It is not good for man to be alone." (Gen. 2:18)

How do we know who and what is God? He told us, in the Bible! He longs to reveal Himself to us! John wrote, "God is Love", not God has Love. It means that for all eternity, there was (and is) in God a Lover, a Beloved, and the Love between them. Father. Son. Holy Spirit. He created us in His own likeness. That likeness is expressed in a fundamental way in the family. The love between husband and wife gives rise to a child.

What does this mystery teach us about marriage and married life? First, that man and woman are equals, just as the Father and the Son are equal (but different in the way they relate to one another.) That equality is reflected in the first reading, the story about the creation of Eve. God wanted a partner for Adam. Only when Adam saw Eve, could he say, "This is at last love of my love, flesh of my flesh." That equality between man and woman is, according to the Bible, the ground for their intimacy and their partnership. "Therefore a man leaves his father and his mother and clings to his wife, and they become one flesh." (Gen. 2:24) This equality is often forgotten in both the Asian and South American cultures.

What else can we learn, from the likeness of married life to the Trinitarian life of God Himself? And from the biblical story of Creation? In today's Gospel, Jesus Himself quotes Genesis, "And the two shall become one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate." (Mark 10) Jesus is telling us that the physical union of two flesh is good and wanted by God. Because it is God who joined man and woman in marriage. God does not make mistakes. Sex is pleasurable, God wanted it to be so. That pleasure, which can lead us to joy and true self-giving, is not a concession, a compromise that God made with the devil! Thomas Aguinas, the greatest theologian of the Catholic Church, said that sex would be more pleasurable in the Garden of Eden before the disorder brought upon by original sin! Sin reduces sex to be "shared egotism." "I get my kicks, you get yours." The "hook up" of culture turns men and women into savvy head-hunters. Casual sex without commitment reduces the other, to make him/her a means of sensual and emotional satisfaction. But true, radical self-giving, in the likeness of the love between Father and Son, lift up the matrimonial love. It becomes a way through which God calls us, loves us, and strengthens us.
