CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY

June 18th, 2006



Dear Parishioners, At the beginning of the liturgical renewal, forty years ago, some theologians thought that the traditional adoration of the Blessed Sacrament would fall into oblivion, to be replaced by more frequent Holy Communion. It did not happen. Wherever the Church is alive, adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is still popular.

Of course, we know that God is everywhere, not only in the Tabernacle. But we know that in the consecrated host, God is present in a very personal way as the Second Person of the Trinity, and in a very human way, as Christ, in his human nature and in his divine nature. Christ in his Resurrected Body, is there, sacramentally, but really there, "actively". He is loving us, looking at us, inviting us to respond to him as beloved disciples.

St. Thomas Aquinas, the great theologian, would go pray in front of the Blessed Sacrament to seek a solution to a difficult theological problem. He would even put his writings on the altar of the Blessed Sacrament.

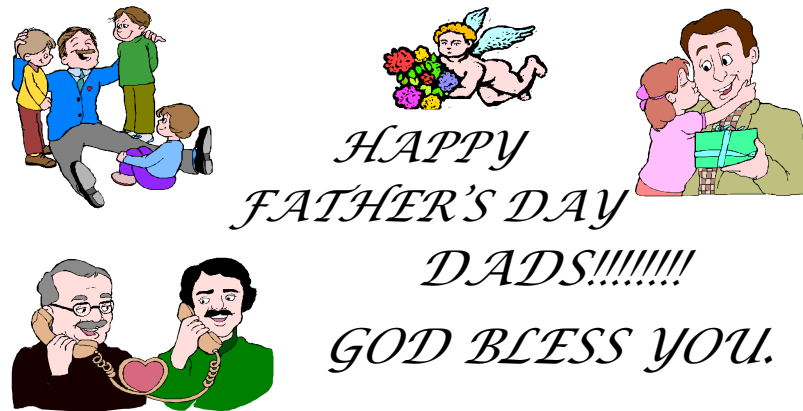
As for myself, despite my inclination towards new ways of praying and "new" spiritualities, I have always found great consolation, and strong determination in front of the Blessed Sacrament, especially during hardships. It was in front of the Blessed Sacrament, that I got the confirmation of my calling to the priesthood. And so it was for Blessed Charles de Foucauld, Thomas Merton and many more. It was in front of the Blessed Sacrament that I discovered how much God loved me, and at the same time, feeling I was just like a grain of sand in his hand. And it is in front of the Blessed Sacrament that I pray everyday, feeling so close to the powerful and all encompassing God. It is in front of the Blessed Sacrament that I can "connect" my personal prayer to the prayers of all the parishioners of St. Mary, to all the liturgies that are celebrated in our church and in the Universal Church. In front of the Blessed Sacrament, facing Jesus Christ, I am connected to the Saints in heaven and to the departed in purgatory. I am connected to the Heart of the Universe and the Heart of God. *May he bless you, Fr. Pierre.*

HEALING MASS BY FR. JERRY ORBOS,SVD, at ST. MARY'S CHURCH

Fri. Jun. 23 at 7:30pm. Fr. Jerry Orbos, SVD (Society of the Divine Word), is internationally known for his healing masses, talks, retreats and pilgrimages to the Holy Land, Fatima, Medugorje and other Marian shrines. He was a missionary to Korea where he experienced a "Eucharistic miracle" with the visionary Julia Kim at Naju. At present he is the Mission Director of the SVD Mission Office which is tasked to raise funds for Filipino SVD missionaries working abroad and to foster mission awareness. Fr.
