Dear Parishioners, When she was still an atheist, Dorothy Day got pregnant twice. The first time she had an abortion. But the second time, she kept the baby and felt so grateful for the gift of life in her womb, that she wrote, "For the beauty of life in me, I felt the need for someone to be grateful to". She started searching for God and found him so well that she became a "saint". Gratitude is a pathway to God, and to a meaningful life.

Think about it! Life would be absurd if we could not say "Thank you so much"! to its Author and at the same time, knowing that He himself is receiving our expression of gratitude with divine joy.

For the last few months, I have been starting nearly every day with at least half an hour in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament expressing gratitude and praises to God. I don't always have a very specific reason to be grateful for, when I begin my prayer time. I start by praising the Father for waking up alive this morning, praising Jesus Christ for the Passion and Death he suffered for me, for His presence in the Tabernacle. This usually awakens my memory: events, providential coincidences, graces and persons to be grateful for come to my mind and lift up my heart. After a while, I listen to God as He inspires me to ask for more favors, more divine graces for myself and my people. And ask for His mercy for my sins and our sins.

Expressing gratitude is the best way I know to initiate prayer. It is like priming a manual water pump by pouring in it a bucket of water. It opens up the well of living water flowing from the Spirit in our heart. A grateful heart is a magnet drawing to itself the blessings of God and the friends of God. Grateful persons will soon discover that the greatest joy is to "feel" the joy of God himself echoing in their lives.
