Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners, Fr. Pierre had shared with you last Sunday as to how passages from the Bible can be a means for God to speak to each one of us afresh

each and every day in light of our own personal life's experiences. As such, both Fr. Pierre and I thought it would be a great idea to introduce you to some simple steps to help you pray with the Bible so that *His Word* can become truly *alive* in our hearts and in our lives each and every day.

The steps that I want to introduce you to is called *lectio divina*. It is a fancy Latin word to mean *divine reading* or *holy reading* and calls for 4 simple steps. This method was introduced in the 12th century by a Carthusian monk by the name of Guigo but can already be traced all the way back to the early 3rd century:

Preparation: a) Set aside at least 1/2 an hour each day. **The key is to select the same time and same place that is away from distraction to devote to prayerful reading, and to keep it.* This leads to a daily habit of prayerful reading that becomes most effective. b) Before reading the Bible passage for the day, take a few moments to still yourselves with deep, regular breathing and invite the *HOLY SPIRIT* to guide the prayerful reading time. You are now ready for the 4 simple steps. **4 Simple Steps:** **1) Read:** Read the Bible passage or the Gospel reading for the day slowly a couple of times. **2) Meditate:** Reflect on the text of the passage and think as to how it can be applied to your own life. If a particular word or phrase jumps out at you, stop reading and stay with it. Reflect on the word or phrase to see how it can be applied in your own life. **3) Share:** Open your heart to God and begin a conversation with God about what spoke to you in that word or phrase. **4) Contemplate:** Listen attentively to God speaking to you in return. To do this well, we must open our very selves - our mind, heart and soul - to God, and free ourselves from the busyness of our own thoughts so as to listen to God speak to us. Any good conversation must allow both parties to speak. When you have done this, continue reading until another word or phrase jumps out at you, at which point you **repeat** the 4 simple steps. This is all there is to *Lectio Divina!* It's as easy as that! If you prefer to prolong this prayerful reading time, stretch it out to 1 hour, or 1/2 hour in the morning and 1/2 hour in the evening.

In September 2005, Pope Benedict XVI noted, I would like in particular to recall and recommend the ancient tradition of *Lectio divina*: the diligent reading of Sacred Scripture accompanied by prayer brings about that intimate dialogue in which the person reading hears God who is speaking, and in praying, responds to him with trusting openness of heart... If it is effectively promoted, this practice will bring the Church - I am convinced of it - a new spiritual springtime."

Happy, Healthy and Holy Divine Reading! God Bless, *Fr. Mark*
