Free-falling!



Dear Parishioners, many, many moons ago, when I was a young high-school lad, I remember participating in an event in a leadership program that has remained with me until today. In this event, each of us had to walk across rather lengthy knotted ropes that were suspended some 7-8 feet in mid-air, and that were tied between the branches of two trees. When we arrived at the middle point of the rope, we were supposed to close our eyes and free-fall backwards. Now, the sensation of free-falling was certainly scary for me, but relief came afterwards when I fell into the interlocking arms of fellow friends and members. Of course this activity was meant to build trust with one another, and the wonderful thing is that it drove home its point, so much so that I still remember this event quite clearly to this very day.

Now, just like what I have just shared with you, *surrendering* ourselves over to God by giving over one or another aspect of our lives to Him is certainly not an easy thing to do, and it is difficult precisely because it calls us to be *vulnerable* to God. In a sense, we are to close our eyes and free-fall backwards and wait for God to respond in His own good time. But, as Fr. Pierre shared with us in last week's *Pastor's Corner*, if we want God to work in one or another aspect of our lives that we may be dissatisfied with, be it recurring anger, deeply rooted bitterness, dissatisfaction with our job, drugs, alcohol, etc., then we are called to do precisely this – to give God the permission to do His work in our lives, in His own good and perfect time. In other words, to free-fall backwards and wait and trust that He will indeed catch us in His arms!

And, you know what, the wonderful thing is that God ALWAYS catches us when we *surrender* ourselves over to Him, or when we give Him permission to do His work in our lives! And, oftentimes, we find out that the way God catches us or works in our lives is not quite what we expected. For God's ways are not our ways! But as Jeremiah 29.11 also reminds us, God's plans for us will always be ultimately for the good: "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

So, brothers and sisters, let yourselves go, in those aspects of your lives that you are dissatisfied with..., close your eyes and free-fall backwards, and watch God catch you in His arms. A catch that will transform your life, forever!

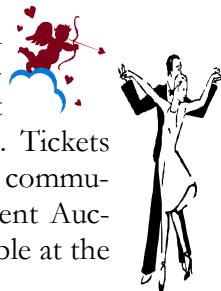
