# Living in the Power of the Holy Spirit

Dear Parishioners, last week Fr. Pierre spoke to you about the means to overcome temptations. He gave the wonderful allusion that through our baptism we are connected to the Resurrected Body of Christ as branches are connected to the vine. As such, it is through our truly believing in, and claiming the victory of, Christ's resurrection in our lives, that we can already trust that the power of Christ is slowly working in our lives to turn us away from temptations that can keep us feeling degraded, soiled and humiliated.

This week, we will reflect on how is it that we can claim the victory of Christ's resurrection for ourselves so that we can turn away from temptations. The means to do so is to 1) surrender ourselves to the reality of the Holy Spirit that is already dwelling in our lives through the waters of baptism, and 2) to pray for the outpouring and fruition of the gifts of the Holy Spirit that has already been given to us at baptism. The Holy Spirit is not just an intellectual concept of the 3rd person of the Trinity that we assent to at baptism and confirmation. Rather, the Holy Spirit truly strengthens us and fortifies us against the forces of temptation and sin. After his resurrection, Christ told his disciples in Acts 1.4-8 that they would be baptised with the Holy Spirit and will receive power from on high.

And, what is this power of the Holy Spirit for? 1) One of the results of the power of the Holy Spirit is to convict us of sin. This is an ongoing ministry and work of the Holy Spirit that helps us to turn away from the temptations that can lead us to sin so that we can grow in *holiness* of character. 2) The power of the Holy Spirit also helps us bring forth the fruits of the Holy Spirit in our lives. One of the fruits of which is self-control, that is, the means to identify temptations and to stay away from them. Other fruits can also be charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, and chastity. 3) Finally, the power of the Holy Spirit will also help Christians to have the desire and conviction to witness the Good News of Our Lord Jesus Christ to others. As Acts 1.8 reminds us, "you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses...to the ends of the earth." (Contd....)

It is for the above reasons, therefore, that we are to continually nurture the presence of the Holy Spirit dwelling in our lives. For the guarantee is given to us by our Lord himself that, if we do so, we will indeed see the fruits of His resurrection coming alive in our lives. Amen. *God Bless, Fr. Mark.*
