**"Holy Spirit 2 – Emboldening"**

Dear Parishioners, Last week I shared with you as to how the power of the Holy Spirit in our lives can give us the strength to *convict us of sin and to turn away from sin by resisting temptation*. Today, what I would like us to focus on is to ask ourselves *how* the Holy Spirit can strengthen us and *embolden* us not only to resist or flee away from temptation but also to live and share God's message *in season and out of season*.

I shall begin by sharing my personal story once again. It happened when I was 20 years old in 3<sup>rd</sup> year university at Simon Fraser University going through an ethics course. At the end of the course, while sitting with a group of students over coffee, one suddenly stood up to enquire if each one of us believed that the *foetus* in the womb is really a child. Each one shook their heads with a resolute "no". Now it so happened that I was the last of the 4 or 5 to be asked and because everyone said "no", even if I believed otherwise as a practicing and believing Catholic, under group pressure, I too said "no"! I remember leaving the group with a very heavy heart and *ironically* (\*God often works through ironic situations to bring about changes in our lives, doesn't He?) I was just heading for a bible study with other university students. And, just as I entered the doorway, what did I hear, but this ringing passage being read out from:

*2 Timothy 1:6-8: "I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands. For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline. So do not be ashamed to testify about our Lord, or ashamed of me his prisoner. But join with me in suffering for the gospel, by the power of God..."*

**Bam!** Those words hit me like a load of bricks, reminding me of the gift of the Holy Spirit given to me at baptism and confirmation to be nurtured through a life of deepening relationship with Christ. You could say a deep *shift* occurred in my life after that eventful day such that, to the extent that I deepened my *love relationship with Christ* in my life, to that extent as well was I the more *emboldened* to share the good-news of God *in season and out of season*.

Of course the Holy Spirit, who is the One God, can work in our lives to strengthen and *embolden* us in any which way desired, but doing so through *ironic* moments or moments of *crisis* in our lives, seems to be a common occurrence. Think about St. Peter, and the other Apostles. Was it not after deserting Christ, then likely feeling low and bad about it, and suddenly the Resurrection appearances and the *Pentecost* experience of the Holy Spirit that they were then emboldened to proclaim the Good-News of Jesus Christ. During this Lenten Season, let us dare to ask our Lord for those life-changing experiences in our own lives as well. That we too may then be emboldened to go out to share the Good-News of Our Lord Jesus Christ *in season and out of season*. Amen.

Oravec, O.S.B., a monk of the Dormition Abbey in Jerusalem, is visiting Vancouver to inform his brother Benedictines at Westminster Abbey, and others who may be interested, of plans of the Dormition Abbey to establish the Beit Benedict Peace Academy on Mt. Sion. This is a response to the requests of Palestinian and Israeli peace-makers to expand spiritual, cultural and educational programs that foster reverence and reconciliation. Now is a crucial time for Christians in the Holy Land. It is estimated that less than 3,000 Christians remain in Jerusalem and the total Christian population is less than 2%.
