Mary's had a "Discerning Your Gifts" workshop given by Sr. Marie Bouchard, CSJ and sponsored by the CWL of St. Mary's. And, at the

writing of this week's Pastor's Corner, Fr. Pierre and I were also attending a weeklong workshop-conference that is related to the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. So, why all this talk on reflecting and discerning our gifts? Because as we fast approach the Feast of Pentecost in precisely three Sundays' time, we are reminded that it was on the very day of Pentecost, according to the 2<sup>nd</sup> chapter of the Book of Acts, that the disciples were given gifts by the power of the Holy Spirit coming upon them. But, the gifts given to them were not meant to be kept aside, stuffed somewhere in their sock drawer, never to be used, nor were these gifts meant for the disciples' own personal glorification either! Rather, the gifts of the Holy Spirit were meant to prepare the hearts and minds of their hearers and observers to be open to receiving the Good News of Jesus Christ Risen from the Dead! Peter, the head of the disciples, is said to have stood up and proclaimed that on that day the gifts of the Holy Spirit will be manifested on all humanity, and through the manifestation of these gifts, others too will be attracted to the reality of the Good News that Jesus Christ is indeed Risen from the Dead! It is no wonder that through the manifestation of these gifts in the lives of the disciples and in the bold proclamation by St. Peter of his Christian faith, some 3000 were baptized as Christians on that day, and added to their number. Now imagine that happening at St. Mary's - 3000 being baptized and received into the Church at Easter. Okay, let's be a little more conservative and let's say 100 instead of 3000. Of course the Easter Vigil will be that much longer and the voices of the choir will be that much more strained at the end! Far fetched, you say? Impossible, you say? Well, Fr. Mascarenhas, a Jesuit priest, was sharing publicly at this week's workshop-conference of his recent trip to China a

month ago, and apparently, approximately 500 catechumens

were waiting to be baptized in each of the Catholic parishes that

he visited in cities all over China!

So, why is that not happening in most parishes here in Vancouver, brothers and sisters? Why instead is there this ongoing joke among Catholics here in Vancouver that after Confirmation you don't see them at Church anymore? Is it perhaps possible that we may just be taking the potential power of the Holy Spirit and the gifts of the Holy Spirit at Confirmation for granted..., that Confirmation is a ritual to have done and over with, such that any potential gift(s) of the Holy Spirit are stuffed into a sock drawer and forgotten? Let me urge you instead to consider this passage of St. Paul to young Timothy once again (2 Timothy 1:6-8) "That is why I am reminding you now to fan into a flame the gift of God that you possess through the laying on of my hands. God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but the Spirit of power and love and self-control. So you are never to be ashamed of witnessing to our Lord...but share in my hardships for the sake of the gospel, relying on the power of God..." And, as scripture assures us, we will see that 100 or 500, and ves, even 3000 catechumens vet! God Bless. Fr. Mark.
