Pastor's Corner

Sunday, May 13th, 2007 Beware of C.I.A.



Dear Parishioners,

The C.I.A is after you! Not the Central Intelligence of America, but the C.I.A. of the Enemy. Condemnation. Intimidation. Accusation. C.I.A. These are the favorite tools of the Enemy. The Enemy uses them to isolate each one of us from one another, from God and from our true self. The Enemy uses these tools to put ourselves up against one another and against God and destroy the Power of God's Promises in us. "Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not be afraid. Peace I leave with you; my Peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives". (From today's scripture in John 14).

Let us look at the "C" of C.I.A.: Condemnation. Suppose you go to confession regularly, but you don't feel forgiven. The devil, using your own psychological "problems" as a leverage, will suggest to you that you are not really forgiven, "How dare you think you are forgiven! Don't you feel the guilt?" Don't dialogue with him. Pretty soon, you would start acting like someone condemned by God. Rather, act and speak as a forgiven person!

Now let us look at the "A" of C.I.A.: Accusation. When I was a kid, my mother told me over and over again, "What are we going to do with you?" Sometimes it was said in an affectionate way. But when she was angry, these words were like a dagger in my heart, and for a while, I would start acting like a useless, hopeless person. Try to remember some of these words that a teacher or a relative, or a "friend" used as a dagger against you. "You will never amount to anything." "You are a looser." "Why can't you be like your brother." Cast these words out of your life. Let the peace of Christ displace them. "Do not be afraid! You are my beloved in whom I find Joy."

The "I" of C.I.A. stands for Intimidation. The Enemy, using your own lack of self-esteem, or using the jealousy of others, will say, "How dare you think that God cares for you! Who are you? You are not Mother Theresa! You are not one of those "movers and shakers" who make a difference in God's plan. Why would God care about your little problems? (Contd.....)

You are a sinner. How dare you pray for others! How dare you witness the Gospel! Shut up and hide!

All these words are lies. The Enemy is the Father of lies. Lie is his native tongue. "The peace that I give you is one that nobody can take away from you", says God. "Let ME be your source of security, your source of identity and your source of holiness.
