Pastor's Corner

December 13, 2009 - 3rd Sunday of Advent GOD IN YOUR PLAYPEN

A young couple with a two-year-old toddler had invited Fr. Hampsch for dinner. From where Fr. Hampsch was sitting in the living room, he could watch the little boy hanging around his mother's legs while she was handling a hot pot of soup. She had tried in vain to have the boy move away, but he would not listen. She finally put him into his playpen. The boy started weeping and weeping! By that time, his father, who had been talking with Fr. Hampsch, could not enjoy the conversation anymore, not because of the noise his son made, but because he was moved with pity. He could not take the boy out of the playpen, because he did not want to disobey his wife's orders. So he did the only thing he could! He jumped into the playpen with his son. There he comforted him with a warm hug and sang his child's favourite song. It was quite a sight to behold, this big man in a small playpen. Fr. Hampsch wondered who was the happiest of the two -- the toddler or the father? Of course it was the father who felt the most joy!

Fr. Hampsch understood the meaning of today's first reading from Zephaniah 3:17-18 "The Lord, your God, is in your midst (...) He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will renew you in His love. The Lord, your God, will exalt over you with loud singing as on a day of festival." Can you imagine God, the King of the Universe, singing for joy over you, taking you to his cheek, coming down into your playpen, planet earth, to wipe your tears? Can you hear Him whisper "Come, enter into the joy of your Master"? (Matthew 24:21) This is what we celebrate at Christmas. God comes down into our playpen. It is called Incarnation. With His human arms, He hugs you.

When you were a little child, the sight of your mother and father rejoicing over you was your greatest source of joy, of affirmation, of security. Today, let God, your Father, take His delight over you. Let Him come down into your playpen! Accept that He rejoices over you even when you feel like an (con't)

unworthy sinner. He came for the sick, not for those who think they do not need the doctor!

"Rejoice in the Lord always, again I say, Rejoice" (Philippians 4,4)
