**GOD SPOKE YOU INTO EXISTENCE**

How amazing it is to watch a baby slowly becoming a free and distinct person, aware of himself as unique. At first, when newly born, he seems to be only a “bundle of instinctual needs”. He wants milk, warmth, comfort, and he wants it now! In this, he seems to be like the other animals. Until the first smile, mirroring the loving smile of his mother. And then, the first word — “mama”. Later he learns to say his name and rejoices in it. If he had never been smiled at, never called by name, he would not have received the capacity to “activate” his sense of being a free and unique person. The great Jewish philosopher, Martin Buber, wrote that we can only exist as an “I” when we are called by a “Thou”. We need to hear our mother calling us by name, just as Adam heard God calling him by name at the dawn of creation. This relationship with the one who engenders us is beautiful but frightening because it implies that we could cease to be if we were separated from the other. We call this the anxiety of separation, the fear of a permanent break of our link to life. This fear never disappears completely in this life, but will disappear in the next life when we will receive ourselves totally and joyfully from God the Father. Right now, we have to accept our dependency on Him and on others, through an act of faith. I believe in You, my God. I trust in You.

This mystery is mirroring what is eternally happening in the Trinity. The Son receives Himself joyfully from the Father and returns all that He is to the Father. From that embrace of the Father and the Son, proceeds the Holy Spirit. Now, what is happening when receive the Holy Spirit through the baptism, the Sacraments and the faith? We are regenerated by the inner life of God, by what is happening between Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We become one with Jesus Christ the Son, and we “hear” the Father calling us by name as He did when Jesus was baptized. “You are my beloved Son in whom I am well pleased. Go fulfill your mission. Financial results for the year ended December 31, 2008 have resulted in a Net Income of \$44,103. A portion of this amount has been deposited in our Chancery Savings A/C which had a balance of \$1.227 million as at 31 Dec. '08. This money is set aside to cover St. Mary's share of the Notre Dame High School reconstruction project which will be roughly \$1.95 million. As of Dec.31'08 we have contributed \$157,502 to Notre Dame. The 2009 budget is projected at a Deficit of \$(-851,500) based on a conservative approach to our parish finances and includes a \$1 million pay out towards the (Contd..)

*(Financial statement contd.)* Notre Dame Secondary School reconstruction. We have accomplished a great deal in 2008, including replacement of the School roof, repainting of the church basement, sanding and polishing of the church front entrance woodwork, re-coated the church brick walls with sealant, installation of additional exterior lighting on the property. Enhanced security by installing additional motion sensors and cameras in the church, basement and rectory, including security patrols, following incidents of theft and vandalism.
