PROJECT ADVANCE -- 2008 UPDATE

Kudos to all parishioners of St. Mary's and in particular to those who contributed to this year's campaign. Your generous donations made it possible for us to achieve our parish's goal of \$80,000. To date the contribution is at \$82,092 which enables the parish not only to cover the administrative expenses, but to receive a rebate for the effort of the parish as well. This year's participation rate is 17.7%. We are pleased with this number but we would be certainly delighted to see a higher percentage of 20% to 25% of all our parishioners to be involved with Project Advance 2009. All rebates will be contributed towards the building fund of Notre Dame Secondary School. Please note that Project Advance tax receipts will be available for pick up together with your parish donation tax receipt near the end of February.
