Pastor's Corner

CHOOSE LIFE!

If we are not attentive to what is happening to us, little things can imperceptibly grow in importance and take over our lives: attachments to "small" stuff...minor addictions...personal habits that lead us to sin. We become obsessed with things that hide the big picture of who we are and who we are called to be. Cars, kitchen renovations, athletic performances, smartphones, sex, food, romance, popularity...And we become miserable instead of joyful; anxious because we don't have what we want and fearful of losing the little we have gained. We spend our energy, time, talents and resources trying to secure things that we think are indispensable. But in that process, we lose everything that is genuine and real.

"For those who want to secure their lives will lose it, and those who give their lives out of love for my sake will secure it" (Matthew16:25) Do you believe those words of Jesus? Not so easy! Original sin has programmed our minds to believe that we cannot trust these words, that we cannot trust God Himself. So we get into all kinds of diversion and distractions, seeking our happiness without reliance on God's Word and Presence. Without Him, we fall into discouragement.

We need to return to our origin: God. We were created in His own image, made for sacrificial love, like Jesus. There is no other way to true joy and fulfilment: to love God and His children more than ourselves just as Christ loved His Father more than Himself, and gave up His life for us. Do you want to wake up everything with the desire to do something beautiful for God and for others?

But there is more to it. If we rather choose the evil path of self-centeredness and self-absorption, we will become a stumbling block for our loved ones, for the Church, for those who are placed in our life, private and public. Christ Pastor's Corner Continued...



will say to us, like He said to Peter, "Get behind me Satan. You are a stumbling block to me, for you are setting your mind not on divine things, but on human things." (Matthew 16:23)

How often, have I been a stumbling block for others in the Church, throughout my life! It is never too late to change that. I keep thinking of the "good" thief who entered paradise with the Crucified Jesus. I try to identify with Paul who wrote "I can do everything in Him who strengthen me."

But here's the Good News. The way of self sacrificing love is contagious. It will eventually, in God's time, remove all the evil of this world. "The gates of Hades will not prevail against it." (Matthew 16:18) The devil said about St. John Vianney: "Just three men like him and my kingdom would be ruined." Obviously we didn't get those three men like him. Could we not find these three persons in our parish? Or maybe three hundred "ordinary" saints? The reward for them is to receive in this life a hundred times all they will have given away and eternal life in the Kingdom of God.
